MADE IN THE USA FACT SHEET



Over 90% of Reynolds Services US shipments are from domestically sourced steel.



Reynolds Services' relationships with domestic suppliers and diverse inventory will help ensure that you are provided US material while other service centers rely heavily on foreign material.



Unless the product is for the automotive or textile industry there is no standard that requires manufacturers to put "Made in USA" on the product.





The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) is charged with preventing deception and unfairness in the marketplace regarding misleading claims of "Made in USA".



Per the FTC Standard "all or virtually all" of the product must be made in the USA - this means that all significant parts and processing that go into the product must be of US origin.





In December 1997, the FTC announced that it would retain the "all or virtually all" standard with regard to claiming "Made in USA".



To make a "Made in USA" claim the final assembly of the product must be done in the USA.





The products final assembly or processing must take place in the USA.



The product should contain no or negligible foreign content.





The FTC will review the percentage of the cost of the product, the raw materials used, and how far removed from the finished product the raw materials are when determining a "Made in USA" claim.
